## Eliminator Format

Draw for pairs. Scores Carry over after each round. Bowl 2 games, cut field in half. Bowl 1 games, cut field in half. Continue until 5 bowlers remain based off of qualified entries.
Top 5 bowlers will advance to step-ladder finals. Step-Ladder will consist of 1 game matches.

1. Bowlers will move 1 pair of lanes to the right at the conclusion of each game.
2. Tournament is open to all USBC Certified Members. This includes Junior Bowlers. Junior's money will be deposited into the Smart Account.
3. Handicap will be based on $70 \%$ of 220 with a cap of 45 pins, based off of 2023 Composite, minimum 21 games. If no 2023, can use 2022 composite, minimum 21 games. If neither, bowler will be scratch.
4. The tournament director has the right to rerate the average of any entrant. Sport and/or Challenge pattern averages will receive adjusted average. If entrant has qualified for a prize of $\$ 500$ or more in any tournament event, entrant must report all such prizes, and tournament placement. Failure to report tournament winnings will result in disqualification. If the rerated average is unacceptable to the entrant, the entry fee shall be refunded and participation will not be allowed.
5. If entrant uses higher average than actual, scores bowled will remain unchanged. If a lower than actual average is used, the entrant will be disqualified from the tournament.
6. Bowlers MUST report 30 minutes prior to squad time. This includes re-entry.
7. House/Tournament personnel are eligible to participate.
8. Reservations are strongly recommended; however, you may enter on site provided spots are available. Max of 64 bowlers per squad.
9. If a youth bowler qualifying score is higher than an adult score, the score will bump into the adult qualifying scores and allow the next youth bowler to qualify into the eliminator.
10. Premature termination of the tournament due to war, national emergency, natural disaster, fire, or any other reason beyond the control of the tournament director shall, to the extent require, cause all advertised prizes, guaranteed to otherwise, to be pro-rated in accordance with the number of entries bowled in each of the divisions at the time of tournament termination.
The Tournament director reserves the right to reject or rerate any entrant at any time.
