## Rules:

1. The lowa Senior Bowling Committee requires that all entrants be members of an lowa local association or have been a resident of lowa for at least 30 days prior to the time he is scheduled to compete in the tournament. The tournament is open to all male bowlers 50 years of age or more as of December 31, 2024. Verification of lowa membership must be sent with all members who do not have an lowa Address. Entrants will compete in the age class according to their age at the end of the calendar year in the Singles and All Events. Age is required for all entrants on the entry form.
2. Bowlers must be current USBC members during the 2023-2024 bowling season.
3. Bowlers must check in $\mathbf{3 0} \mathbf{~ m i n}$. before scheduled time to bowl. Substitutes should check in $\mathbf{1} \mathbf{h r}$. prior to bowling.
4. In the event of any ties for plaques, duplicate awards will be issued.
5. USBC rules will govern this tournament. All scores qualifying for USBC awards must be reported to the manager.
6. USBC tournament Rule 319-A item2 ,E\&D [report of current average 10-pins higher than last season], tournament average adjustment,report of previous tournament winnings],] are Waived
7. Entering average:

2022-2023 season highest USBC league average of 21 or more games.
If no average last year, use highest 2023-2024 USBC league average at the time of entry of 21 or more games bowler must provide a league standing sheet showing current season average. Bowlers without last year or current season average of 21 games or more must use an average of 150. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. (USBC Tournament Rule 319A, item 3)
8. You may enter multiple times in doubles \& singles. You must change your doubles partner and you can only cash once in the top 10 of singles in your division. Your first doubles \& singles scores will be used for All-events.
