TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Trios competition Saturday, March 9, 2024, at The Suncoast Bowling Center 9090 Alta Dr., Las Vegas, NV 89145.
- 2. We will bowl 4 games on same pair.
- 3. 2 squads available: 9:00am and 1:00pm. Check in starts at 7:30am and 11:30pm.
- 4. Re-entry allowed, but MUST change at least 1 teammate.
- 5. Pre-registration is REQUIRED. Walk-ins will not be accepted.
- 6. Youth Bowlers **ARE NOT** permitted to bowl this event.
- 7. Current PBA/PWBA national tour players are excluded from this event. Players with national title wins within the past 5 years are also excluded.
- 8. Only one PBA/PWBA player per team.

9. Entry Fee is \$195 per team (\$65 per bowler). Fee breakdown: Prize fund – \$117; Lineage – \$48; Expenses – \$30.

- 10. 1:6 doubles entries will cash
- 11. Team Handicap is 90% of the difference between the team average and 630.
- 12. Maximum individual score per game is 300 with or without handicap.
- 13. Teams may consist of any three (3) bowlers. A female MUST bowl in the anchor position).
- 14. Minimum individual entering average: 140 per bowler.
- 15. Optional Singles: 4 divisions: Men's Scratch; Women's Scratch; 175 avg. and above; 174 avg. and below.
- 16. Entry Fee for optional singles is \$40. Fee breakdown: Prize fund \$34; Expenses \$6
- 17. 1:6 entries in singles will cash.
- 18. Minimum 6 entries/division. If fewer than 6 entries in a division, divisions will be combined.
- 19. Singles handicap is 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220.
- 20. Bowlers who average less than 220 may enter both scratch and handicap divisions but MUST pay the \$40 entry fee for both divisions. Handicap bowlers cannot bowl the "over/under". Bowlers who average 220 or higher can only enter scratch division.
- 21. Prize funds for both Trios and singles will be paid out shortly after tournament play ends.
- 22. Bowlers must use highest USBC standard composite average from 2022-23 and 2021-22 seasons. If the bowler does not have a current book average, the current league average with at least 21 games may be used.
 - · If your current league average is more than 10 pins above your USBC standard composite, a composite of your current league averages will be used.
 - · Bowlers using current league average MUST provide current league sheet prior to the start of competition.
- 22. Bowlers without current book or current league average MUST bowl scratch (220 avg.).
- 23. It is each bowler's responsibility to report the correct average. Averages will be verified before event payout. Failure to report correct average may result in disqualification.
- 24. Bowlers must report any re-rates within the past 5 years.
- 25. Tournament director reserves the right to re-rate players at any time.

- 27. Electronic payments WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED after March 6, 2024. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 28. Optional high game side pots \$20 (covers all 4 games); Brackets \$5 each; Eliminator Pots \$15
- 29. 300 jackpot \$10 (carries over if no one rolls a scratch 300-game). Only scratch 300 is eligible to win the 300 jackpot. If multiple 300's are rolled during this event, jackpot will be split equally between each of those bowlers. If a bowler rolls multiple 300 games in this event, that bowler will receive an equal share for each 300 game bowled.
- 30. Oil Pattern: 2023 Jr. Gold Youth Open
- 31. This is NOT a USBC-sanctioned event. Decisions made by tournament director are final, binding and not appealable. Any disputes not covered herein will be resolved according to USBC rules.
- 32. In the event of a malfunction, tournament officials will make a reasonable accommodation to resolve the issue.
