YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT

April 20th & 21st, 2024 at Oak Bowl - USBC CERTIFIED

This tournament will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the USBC. Entry into this tournament is open to all youth members of the USBC. Non-USBC youth members may purchase a USBC membership for \$10.00 (\$4.00 for national; \$6.00 for local awards/scholarships & processing fee). Subject to lane availability. Entries for each squad will close 15 minutes prior to the start of each squad and based on lane availability.

DIVISIONS: Handicap Doubles, Handicap Singles, and Scratch Singles. All age groups will be combined within these three divisions.

AVERAGES: Bowlers averaging over 210 must bowl scratch in the singles division. Sport and challenge averages will be converted to standard averages for the purpose of handicaps. Average used for purpose of handicap will be as follows (in order of priority):

- 1) 2022-2023 USBC composite league average of 15 games or more.
- 2) If no 2022-2023 average, current average of 15 games or more will be used.
- 3) If current average is 15 or more pins higher than 2022-2023, current average will be used.
- 4) Bowlers without a verifiable average must bowl scratch singles and enter doubles with 220.

HANDICAP DIVISION: Will be based on 100% of 220 for singles, 100% of 440 for doubles.

SCRATCH DIVISION: No handicap

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:

DOUBLES: May bowl twice with the same partner, but receive awards only once. Entrants may receive awards more than once if done so with a different partner.

SINGLES: May bowl as many times as they wish, but receive awards only once.

AWARDS: Estimated awards shall be at least 1:4 entries. All award fee money collected will be returned 100% to participants as scholarships. In the event of a tie, co-champions will be declared and no roll off will occur. Prize fund will be awarded as SMART funds.

DRESS CODE: No hats, equipment, or clothing advertising alcohol/tobacco products, no offensive or suggestive shirts. Electronic devices, including cell phones are to be turned off while participating in the tournament.
