# The Miss / Ms / Mrs Singles Scratch Tournament

1. Remember to provide your USBC number so that we may verify averages and place each bowler in the proper division. 319abc Rule applies.
  - a. We'll be using your composite book average from 2021-2022 season. If **no book average**, you may provide a current standing sheet closest to the date of the tournament reflecting 21 games or more or a 230 average will be used. Any sport/challenge league or sport/challenge shot average will be adjusted accordingly.
  - b. Juniors are permitted to bowl with a parent / guardian signed prize waiver regarding rule 400 under USBC rules.
2. **Scratch Singles Tournament**
  - a. 3 Divisions:
    - i. **Miss** Division Ladies with 159 averages and under
    - ii. **Ms** Division Ladies with 160 – 179 averages
    - iii. **Mrs** Division Ladies with 180 averages and up
  - b. Saturday Qualifying 8 games per squad 9am check in / 10am start
    - i. Moving 1 pair to the right after every game
    - ii. If there is a tie for the final spot for the match play finals, a 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off will happen after qualifying to determine the final spot.
  - c. Female Juniors are welcome to join in the Miss Ms Mrs Divisions, averages will be verified to place the entrant in the proper division.
  - d. New Bowlers are participants that have not previously bowled this tournament in prior years.
  - e. If you qualify to bowl in the lower division, you may bowl in the upper divisions as well. Cost is \$80 to bowl in the first division then an additional \$50 for each addition division. You may use one set of scores for the divisions you decided to participate into.
  - f. Those who qualify in the upper divisions may not bowl in the lower divisions.
  - g. If you advance to match play, which ever you rank highest will be the division you advance in. You may only advance in one division.
3. **Step Ladder Finals**
  - a. Top five will advance to a TV style step ladder finals.
  - b. 5<sup>th</sup> place vs 4<sup>th</sup> place, winner vs 3<sup>rd</sup> place, winner vs 2<sup>nd</sup> place, winner vs 1<sup>st</sup> place to determine final Winner.
  - c. In case of a tie there will be a 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off.
4. **Tournament expenses and prize fund**
  - a. Entry Fee \$80
  - b. Prize Ratio 1:4, \$30.00 Lineage and Expenses / Prize Fund \$50.00
  - c. Payment of all prize money will be paid out immediately after each bowler is eliminated from the tournament. Female junior bowlers who cash will be paid into their SMART account.
  - d. No Show = No Refund. There will be no refunds issued for dropping out within 10 days of the tournament.
5. Entrants must be pre-registered for each squad times. Walk-in entries will be allowed if space permits. All entrants must be paid in full and checked in 30 minutes prior to start of each squad.
6. You may enter into more than one division as long as you qualify to enter into that Division. Fee is \$50.00
7. Any bowler arriving late for a game or any frame will receive a zero in that frame. Any bowler that needs to leave will receive zero for the remaining frames.
8. Tournament Director reserves the right to make all tournament related decisions.
