## TOURNAMENT PROCEDURES \& RULES

1. Bowler must be a USBC member in good standing.
2. Bowler must be 50 years old as of April 9, 2024.
3. The tournament shall consist of 15 games (three five-game blocks).
4. The tournament field will be cut to the top 18 and top 12 Super Seniors for match play.
5. Fifteen minutes of practice shall be allowed before all qualifying squads.
6. Bowlers are responsible for accuracy of individual scores.
7. Scoring for match play will be a bonus point system with 30 pins awarded for each game won added to your total pins.
8. All pinfall in qualifying shall be dropped before entering match play.
9. All bowlers must wear proper attire (no jeans).
10. Bowlers must have last name on back of shirt.
11. Bowlers must observe all rules of etiquette:
A. Slow bowling must be avoided.
B. Moving to the next pair of lanes during qualifying shall be done when the pair of lanes has been vacated.
12. Prizes - Top 18 Regular Division Finalists + Alternate; Top 12 Seniors + Alternate. Regular Division Champion guaranteed $\$ 2,500$ and Super Senior Champion guaranteed ${ }^{\$ 1,000 \text {. }}$
13. If an alternate must replace a finalist at any time the following will apply:
A. There will be a penalty of 15 pins per game already completed, with a maximum of 60 pins.
B. One ball on each lane for alternate and finalist will be allowed.
14. Position ties:
A. If two or more bowlers are tied after completion of qualifying for the final position a one-game roll-off will be bowled immediately.
B. If a tie should occur in the position round of the finals, the bowler with the highest scratch score will take the higher position.
C. Should a tie occur in step ladder finals a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will occur.
D. Should a tie occur in step ladder finals for 1st and 2nd place, a one-game roll-off will be bowled.
15. The tournament will have a maximum of 5 players per pair limiting the field to 130 entrants. Paid entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.
16. The Tournament Director shall rule on all disputes.
