- 1. This is an individual scratch tournament open to all current USBC female members.
- 2. The 2023-24 City Queens champion will receive money and a trophy.
- 3. Entry fee shall be \$60.00. All walk-in entries on the day of the tournament will be \$60.00. Entries will close 30 minutes prior to start time of tournament.
- 4. Check-in time will start at 9 a.m. and tournament bowling will start at 10:00 a.m.
- 5. Tournament will begin on March 10, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. with practice starting at 9:45 a.m. Entrants will draw for starting lane. You will bowl 4 games. One out of every 4 entries will advance to the semi-final. <u>NO PIN FALL CARRY OVER</u>. Semi-finalists will bowl three games. The top 4 bowlers will advance to bowl one game TV style finals. All semi-finalists will CASH.
- 6. Those not qualifying for the semi-finals will be bowling the consolidation bracket. <u>NO PIN FALL</u> <u>CARRY OVER</u>. Consolation bracket will consist of 3 games and the winner from this bracket will advance to the 5th position of the TV finals.
- 7. The top 4 semi-finalists and the winner from the consolation bracket will advance to bowl a one game TV style final. The winner from the consolation bracket will bowl the 4th finalist and the winner from that match would bowl the 3rd place and so on.
- 8. If a tie exists, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off shall immediately be held. Failure of any contestant to remain available in case of a tie will constitute a forfeit. A 9th and 10th fame will be rolled until the tie is broken.
- 9. School students, who have not attained the age of 18, must furnish written authorization signed by a parent or guardian. Written authorization must be filed with the entry form unless her parent or guardian will accompany the student to check in, where a consent form may be filed.
- 10. We will make a deposit in the SCUSBC Smart account for any female youth bowler that cashes.
- 11. All other USBC rules will apply.
- 12. Prize fund will be returned 100 percent.
- 13. Bowl at your own risk.
- 14. Tournament Director makes the final decision on all disputes.
