# 2024 Oregon State Senior Qualifying Tournament

## PLEASE READ ALL TOURNAMENT RULES BEFORE COMLPETING ENTRY

All entrants must be at least 50 years of age and be a current member of the Oregon State USBC. Current members of any Professional Bowlers Association will NOT be permitted to bowl the tournament.

There are SIX separate classifications of qualifying (based on age at the time of qualifying) for both Open and Women's Divisions.

See front of entry form for age classification. Be sure you circle the Division (Open or Women's) you are competing in, and check the appropriate box for the **age classification as of the date of your first squad**.

Qualifying consist of two 3 game blocks (6 games total) with handicap to determine standings. Entrants may re-enter this tournament, but only cash once. All games may be completed in one day, or over any two days of the tournament.

AVERAGES: Average will be determined in the following order:

- 1) Highest 21 or more game Standard/House average for 2023-24 (including summer): if none then
- 2) Highest 21 of more game Standard/House average for 2022-23 (including summer): if none then

3) Current Standard/House average of 21 games or more (standing sheet must be provided): if none then

4) Entrant will use 210

If the only average available is a Sport or Challenge league average of 21 games or more it will be adjusted per USBC Rule 201. **Rule 319a applies: If** a bowler has a current average of 21 games or more that is 10 pins or more higher than the entering average to this tournament. It is each bowlers responsibility to verify accuracy of their average.

HANDICAP: Handicap is based on 90% of the difference between the bowlers average and 230.

The highest 6 game total with handicap bowled in each age classification will receive a paid entry into the USBC National Senior Championships, a Championship Shirt, and reimbursement of up to \$200 for travel expenses (upon completion of the trip and furnishing OSUSBC receipts for expenses). In the event of a tie after 6 games of qualifying the winner or higher place will be determined by the high singles game score with handicap, if a tie still exists the next highest game with handicap and so on until a winner is determined. Prize Fund will be returned 100% in each age classification with one prize for every 8 entries.

Any situation no covered by these rules shall be governed by USBC Tournament Rules.

Each entrant hereby agrees that the Oregon State USBC, it's officers or agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fee's if the entrant shall be prevented from bowling the tournament trough delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change or premature termination of the tournament which may be brought about by way of national emergencies, or causes relating to fire's, lockouts, labor difficulties, or cause beyond the control of the USBC and the Senior Qualifying Tournament.

All entrants give their express permission to the Oregon State USBC for the use of the name, photograph and/or likeness in any form and/or media without compensation of any kind.
