2019-20 SENIOR TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Eligibility for this tournament is limited to bowlers who are current members of the USBC, SD State USBC and the SFRUSBC. The Senior Tournament is open to all bowlers 50 years of age or older as of the date they bowl.
2. This is a 3 line doubles and singles tournament. You may bowl doubles as many times as you like but you may only place once with the same partner. You may only bowl singles once.
3. Entrants must use their highest USBC certified book average from the previous season (minimum 21 games). If no average per above, they must bowl scratch.
4. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between your average and 220.
5. This tournament shall consist of 2 divisions:
Division A: Doubles - 380 Average and above, Singles - 190 Average and above
Division B: Doubles - 379 Average and below, Singles - 189 Average and below.
6. Payouts will be given on the basis of 1 for every 4 entries.
7. Entry fee: \$20.00 per event (\$11.00 for lineage, \$7.00 for prize fund and \$2.00 for expenses). Entry fees are non-refundable per USBC Rule 314.
8. The tournament shall be bowled at Great Life Suburban Lanes in Sioux Falls, SD. Entrants must check in 15 minutes prior to the start of the shift. The shift will start on time; if a bowler is late they will take 0 for the missed frames. No paces or dummy score may be used.
9. Any errors in scoring must be reported and corrected before completion of games or any obvious error will be corrected by tournament manager.
10. Protests must be submitted in writing to the tournament committee within 3 days of the tournament completion. No unsigned protests will be considered.
11. Entries close at the beginning of the last shift of the tournament.
12. NEW RULE: Rule 327a, Handicap Rule will be in effect - Allows for a game and/or series to be capped at maximum scratch score of 300 per game and 900 per series.
13. NEW RULE: Rule 319d. Reporting Prior Prize Winnings will be in effect - See full USBC Playing Rules for details.

PRIZE FUND WILL BE RETURNED 100%. ALL USBC RULES WILL APPLY.
