Saturday Qualifying Format

3 Qualifying Squads of 6 games. 9am (60 Max) - 1pm (72 Max) - 6:30pm (84 Max). Lane moves will be staggered so you dont follow the same people every game.

- → 1st Entry: \$160: \$115 Prize Fund, \$45 Lineage & Expenses
 → Re-Entry: \$125: \$100 Prize Fund, \$25 Lineage & Expenses
 → Action Only: \$50: \$25 Prize Fund, \$25 Lineage & Expenses. Rules: You must currently be in the cut & must buy-in at least \$50 in side-action. Scores do not count towards qualifying.
- → The Desperado: After the 3rd squad & official cut score annougment, we'll have a 2-Game Desperado on the 3rd squad burn. Cost is \$25 (\$20 Prize Fund/\$5 Lineage & Expenses). The Winner gets a spot in Sunday's matchplay (Which is guaranteed to be \$310+), we pay 2nd at 6 & more at a pay ratio of 1 in 5 (so 3 at 11, 4 at 16, 5 at 21, & so on). 2024 saw 16 Desperado's!

Game ties settled with a 1 ball roll-off, higher seed picks lane & order, if still tied bowlers will switch lanes maintaining the same order. Match winners go to the ladder in seed order.
- → Finals: Stepladder (Planned: 17-18, Practice Pair 23-24)
