Rules

- Only USBC certified bowlers are eligible for competition. Uncertified bowlers may qualify for all USBC services by paying an affiliate membership fee (\$26) prior to bowling.
- 2) Entrants will use their highest 2023-2024 USBC certified average based on a minimum of 21 games. If no 2023-2024 is available, you will use the highest USBC certified average of 21 games or more, as of December 31st, 2024. All others will be assigned a minimum average of 220 by the tournament directors.
- 3) Bowlers will bowl six qualifying games. The field will be cut to 16 bowlers. The top 16 bowlers will return for double elimination one game matches.
- 4) Bowlers on even lanes will move one pair of lanes to the right after each game. EX: Lane 8 moves to lane 10. Lane10 moves to lane 12. ETC... Bowlers on odd lanes will move left.
- 5) During bracket play, lanes will be assigned based on seeding and match results.
- 6) No blind score shall be permitted. A bowler not ready in their regular turn shall receive a zero for each frame missed.
- 7) All USBC rules applying to tournament play will be strictly enforced.
- 8) Foul language, obscene gestures, abuse of equipment, or display of poor sportsmanship will be grounds for disqualification.
- 9) Tournament entry deadline is 30 minutes prior to the event start time.
- 10) In the event of a tie, the bowlers will go to a best ball roll off. Each bowler will roll one shot. The highest pin fall wins. If they tie, they will switch lanes and roll again. This will continue until we have a winner.
- 11) This is a handicap tournament. Handicap will be based on **90% of 220**. Averages will be converted to a challenge shot average.
