## VANCOUVER & DISTRICT TENPIN BOWLING ASSOCIATION YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This is a CTF sanctioned tournament conducted on May 31, 2025, and June 1, 2025, at Splitsville Riverport in Richmond, BC
2. Entry fee will be \$23.00 per event, with the awards fee returned 100%. (Lineage \$18.90, Awards \$3.60, Expense Fee .50 cents.)
3. The tournament will be contested in the following divisions:
  - a. All events (not bowled) no charge  
Divisions: Handicap and Scratch
  - b. Doubles – *derived from singles scores bowled* \$ 4.00 per event
  - c. Three Person Team Bowled \$23.00 per event
  - d. Singles Bowled \$23.00 per event
4. Bowlers will be placed into the following divisions for all events.
  - a. Handicap
  - b. Scratch
5. All participants must be CTF league members participating in a CTF sanctioned league in a bowling center within the geographical confines of the association.
6. Bowlers may enter singles multiple times but will only cash once. Bowlers may enter unlimited doubles but must change partners on each entry. Bowlers may enter unlimited teams but must change at least one bowler per event. Teams and doubles may consist of all boys all girls, or a mix of boys and girls.
7. The first score bowled in singles, doubles and teams will be used to determine all events winners.
8. Handicap will be 100% of 220 and all bowlers over 220 will bowl scratch.
9. The entering average will be the highest of the following:
  - a. Highest 2023/2024 season end average.
  - b. Current average as of April 30, 2025, with a minimum of twenty-one (21) games.
  - c. If no average, bowler must enter with a 220 average.
10. Average adjustment tables and CTF rerate rules apply. Rule 319c and CTF Rule 319 does not apply.
11. Tournament entrants must bowl in the order in which the names appear on the entry form. Substitutes must bowl in the position that they are replacing. Any youth V&DTBA CTF member may bowl as a substitute. Absent and tardy bowlers will receive a score of zero (0) for all frames missed.
12. It is the responsibility of all bowlers to ensure the proper score is recorded on the score sheet. Only Tournament Officials or designated officials may make score corrections.
13. Smoking, Alcohol are prohibited during competition. Headphones will not be allowed on the approach. No flash photography.
14. Appeals and protests must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within 10 days after the prizes are announced.
15. Awards will be presented at a ratio of 1 in 4, or greatest majority of in each division. SCHOLARSHIPS will be awarded to the winners.
16. Bowlers may only finish first in one all events category, with the scratch award taking priority.
17. Entries close thirty (20) minutes before each shift.
18. Participants authorize V&DTBA to take photographs at this event for purposes including, but not limited to website media, newsletter publications, and promotional use.
19. Payments must accompany entry form are to be sent via e transfer.
