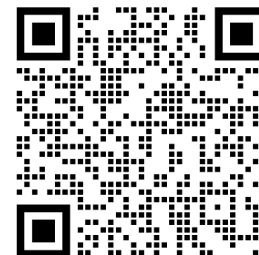

Tournament Rules:

- This is a USBC & Junior Gold certified tournament
 - Participants must be a current member of MAYBE (\$20 annual fee)
 - Participants must be a current member of USBC (\$4 annual fee)
 - Participants adding on Junior Gold must be a current member (annual fee)
- Refer to the MAYBE rules on back
- Any rules not covered will fall under the 2025-2026 USBC rules book.

Mid-America Youth Bowling Events Rules

Mid-America Youth Bowling Events (MAYBE) consist of youth scratch single competition. MAYBE annual membership is \$20.00 per person, valid from 8/1/2025 through 7/31/2026, membership is required to compete in all MAYBE events. Entry fee is \$45.00 (\$15.00 lineage fees and \$30.00 scholarship.) Junior Gold qualifying entry is an optional addition: U18 \$62.50, U16 \$62.50, U14 \$50.00 and U12 \$37.50. U12 Division: Date of Birth 8/1/13 or later. U14 Division: Date of Birth 8/1/11 – 7/31/13. U16 Division: 8/1/09 - 7/31/11. U18 Division: Date of Birth 8/1/07-7/31/09. The tournament director reserves the right to combine divisions or expand scholarship placings based on the number of entries.

Entries can be made on www.tournamentbowl.com. Walk-ins are allowed if space is available.

Bowlers must possess a current USBC membership and a valid USBC Junior Gold membership prior to the start of an event to compete for a Junior Gold spot.

The tournament will consist of five games of scratch competition, moving one pair between games. The top four qualifiers will advance to the stepladder final. Scholarships will be administered through the USBC SMART program. Total pinfall at the end of the five qualifying games will determine Junior Gold advancers. Spots will be awarded at a 1:4 ratio.

In the event of a tie for the Junior Gold advancement spot or all MAYBE ties will be broken by a ninth and tenth frame roll off.

No cellphones or other electronic devices are permitted on the approaches or in the bowler's seating area. The first offense will receive a warning, the second offense will result in dismissal.

Bowlers must always be present and ready to bowl.

Coaching is allowed between frames as long as it does not disrupt the pace of play.

Only bowlers, MAYBE officials or assigned USBC RVPs are allowed in the bowler's area during tournament play. The tables closest to the lanes are reserved for bowlers only.

Each bowler needs to check-in 30 mins prior to the start of the tournament. Any bowlers not present 30 minutes prior to the start of tournament are subject to losing tournament position entry and waitlist and walk-in bowlers will be accepted.

Bowlers need to keep track of their own scores and turn in a signed scorecard at the time of completion of scratch bowling. Not turning in a signed scorecard will result in disqualification.

All score corrections must be approved before they are made and must be made in the frame they occurred.

Appropriate bowling attire is required, including collared or zip-front, mock-collar shirts/jerseys, slacks, dress pants, khakis, dress shorts, skorts or skirts. No jeans, T-shirts, hoodies, leggings, sweatshirts or sweatpants. No bowler or spectator attire should contain profanity, tobacco, alcohol or any drug reference.

Profanity or abusive language or behavior will not be tolerated by bowlers or spectators. ANY USE OF FOUL LANGUAGE OR HAND GESTURES OR ABUSING EQUIPMENT will result in the following actions: warning, forfeiture of 100 pins, or immediate disqualification, subject to the sole discretion of the tournament directors. We ask that you behave as a professional. Spectators may be asked to leave.

Bowling etiquette must be used at all times.

Lane assignments will be determined based on the number of competitors. Every attempt will be made to keep bowlers paired with other bowlers in their specific age divisions.

MAYBE reserves the right to make rule changes throughout the season to adhere to USBC regulations and to ensure competition runs smoothly and effectively. Announcements made on the day of a tournament supersede previously posted information.

All other USBC rules for tournaments and Junior gold qualifiers are to follow USBC rules.

By competing in this tournament bowlers accept all risk and liability.

Follow USBC Rule 329 for any protest.
