PRINCE & PRINCESS TOURNAMENT RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY

All bowlers must be USBC Sanctioned Youth Members.

2. ENTRY FEE

\$40.00 per Bowler. Prize Fund: \$18.00, Lineage: \$20.00, Expenses: \$2.00 Per Event

3. AVERAGES

- The current 2025 – 2026 average will be used (minimum of 21 games).
- Youth advisors must provide a current standing sheet with proof of average, within 1 week of tournament. Current High School standing sheets will be accepted as average verification.
- If the bowler has no average, 230 will be used.
- USBC Rule 319a. 3. Each bowler is responsible for verifying his/her own average, whether submitted by the bowler, or guardian. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
- USBC Rule 319c. Prior to bowling, tournament management may assign a higher average (re-rate) when information indicates the individual may be a better bowler. If this assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fees shall be refunded.
- Rule 319e. (15 pin tournament rule) is waived for this tournament.

4. PRINCE / PRINCESS FORMAT

- Qualifying - will consist of four games across four pairs of lanes.
- Step Ladder Finals – Top 5 will advance to a step ladder final.
- In the event of a tie for any round, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will decide the winner.
- Entrants must report 30 minutes prior to scheduled time. Late bowler rule 322a will prevail.

5. *VIRTUAL SCRATCH SINGLES

Virtual Scratch Singles are available for both Princes and Princesses. There will be one Virtual Tournament for all, with a \$10 entry fee, with all fees being added to the prize list. Suburban South Jersey USBC will match the Scratch Prize Fund.

6. HANDICAP

Singles - Handicap is 90% of 230 average.

7. PRIZE FUND

All prize money collected for each event and each division will be returned 100% in the form of scholarships and placed in the USBC SMART program to the participants in that event or division.

8. ATTIRE

All bowlers are required to wear shirts, pants/shorts that are in good condition, not torn or with holes. Pants/Shorts must be worn at the waist. Skirts and shorts must be at least fingertip length. Please note Rule 301b. All decisions on attire will be made by the tournament manager.

No electronic devices, phones, iPods, etc. may be used during competition (unless used for medical reasons).

A score keeping APP is approved to use during competition.

Bowlers are expected to practice bowling etiquette, 1 lane courtesy and GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP!

Anything that is not covered by the tournament rules listed above will be covered by USBC Rules.

All decisions by Tournament Management are FINAL, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
