Tournament Rules:

- 1. Open to all men and women bowlers age 50 or older by the date of the tournament.
- 2. All tournaments will be scratch bowling, no handicap. All tournaments will be USBC sanctioned, all bowlers must be in good standing with the USBC to be able to bowl.
- 3. Foul language, abuse of bowling center equipment will not be tolerated, please be respectful of others around you when bowling, bowlers will be given one warning, next offense will result in disqualification from tournament with no refund of entry fees.
- 4. Each tournament will consist of 7 games of qualifying, moving after each game, then top 5 stepladder finals. No re-oil before finals. If there is a tie for any position in the top 5, a 9th and 10th frame roll off will be used to determine the winner for each position.
- 5. There will be a \$20 membership fee to be paid before the first tournament is bowled. Half of the membership fee will go to a prize fund to be paid out based on a points system at the end of the year.
- 6. Entry fee will be \$110 per tournament, \$20 lineage, \$5 end of year tournament, \$5 expenses, and \$80 prize fund. Payout will be 1 in 4 entries. Prize payouts will include a \$100 payout for high super senior (over 60) out of the cash.
- 7. Brackets (\$5/set), side-pot (\$15 total) will be offered at each tournament. Side-pots will be pay 3 places, with 15 or more entries. Maximum numbers of brackets a bowler may play is 30.
- 8. All tournaments will be bowled on Sundays. Sign in will start at 9:00 AM, Practice will start at 10:00 AM, tournament play will start at 10:15 AM.
- 9. Tournaments will be bowled on typical house shot, each bowling center will be responsible for the lane conditions.
- 10. Dress code will be enforced, no hats, shorts or t-shirts, preferred dress code will be collared shirt and dress slacks for men or women. Women may wear skirts. Preference is to have last name on back of shirt but not required.
- 11. Lane Courtesy: The NWMOSBT follows the PBA lane courtesy rule, no double jumping, a bowler on the pair of lanes to your right and left much each make a delivery before you are allowed to make your delivery. **Please ask a tournament director if you do not understand this rule.**

12. Points List and Payout:

- A. Bowlers will earn points for each tournament bowled.
- B. Points will be awarded to all bowlers who bowl in a tournament.
- C. Points will be accumulated after each tournament is bowled. The top 5 bowlers on the points list will share will in payout of the points prize fund. For the 2020-2021 tour season the points prize fund will have \$500 in added prize money.
- D. It there is a tie in points for any position within the top 5, the prize money for those positions will be added together and split among those bowlers tied for that position. (I.E. if two bowlers are tied for 2nd place, the prize money for positions 2 and 3 will be added together and paid out to those two bowlers and the next position paid will be 4th place.)



13. End of the Year Tournament:

- A. The end of the year tournament will have added prize money and a normal entry fee if you have bowled a minimum of 4 tournaments during the 2020 2021 tour season. The normal entry fee is \$110.
- B. A bowler may bowl in the end of the year tournament if they have bowled a minimum of 1 tournament during the tour season, the entry fee will be \$160. All extra entry fees collected will go into the prize fund of the year-end tournament.
