#### **JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFIER TOURNAMENT RULES**

- JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFIER: The Junior Gold (JG) Qualifier shall be conducted by the Greater Killeen-Fort Hood USBC. It will be sanctioned by USBC Junior Gold and shall be a singles scratch tournament. Scores will be tallied for 4 games. Side Events may be offered onsite for scholarship funds. This qualifier is NOT a premier event.
- ELIGIBILITY: The tournament shall be open to all members in good standing of the USBC. Youth bowlers must have a current USBC Card and USBC Junior Gold Membership. Youth bowlers should purchase their Junior Gold Membership prior to beginning the tournament. Membership will be available onsite.
- 3. ENTRY FEE. The entry fee is \$60.00 per bowler. Payment of entry fees must accompany entry application. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Refunds shall not be permitted unless the division fails to field the required minimum. There shall be a \$25 fee on any returned checks. Bowlers with a returned check will not be permitted to write checks for future association tournaments. Cash will be accepted on site. MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO GREATER KILLEEN FORT HOOD USBC.
- 4. DIVISIONS.
  - a. Division will first be determined by gender than by their birthdate.
  - b. U12: bowlers whose birthdate is 08/01/2010 or later.
  - U15: Bowlers whose birthdate is 08/01/2007 to 07/31/2010.
  - d. U18: Bowlers whose birthdate is 08/01/2004 to 07/31/2007.
  - e. U20: Bowlers whose birthday is 08/01/2002 to 07/31/2004.
- 5. SCHEDULING & CHECK-IN. Entries will be scheduled in order of receipt. The schedule will not be changed except for emergencies. Lanes will be assigned by the tournament director. The event will be bowled on a pair of lanes. Check-in time is no less than 15 minutes before the scheduled squad time. All participants must have a 2022-2023 USBC membership card and USBC Junior Gold Card. Memberships will be verified by the Association Manager.
- SCHOLARSHIPS/JUNIOR GOLD SPOT
  - The JG Spot will be awarded based on a 1 in 5 ratio after the 4-game qualifier.
  - In the event the spot awardee has already qualified, the JG spot will be given to the next qualifier in line.
  - All prize money collected will be returned 100% to bowlers in form of an entry or scholarship money placed in the USBC SMART Fund.
  - d. Association will be adding \$100 to each division.
  - In the event of a tie for first place in any event, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll off.
- VERIFICATION: It shall be all bowlers' responsibility to verify the accuracy of their averages. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction before

- completion of the first game will disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average thus resulting in a different division.
- 8. SCORING. A tournament entrant will not be allowed to re-bowl a game or series except as authorized by the Tournament Director when the scores are irretrievably lost from an automatic scoring device. Any scoring corrections must be accomplished prior to the end of the game. House shot will be used.
- PROTESTS & APPEALS. The tournament director shall decide any question not covered by these tournament rules and shall have authority to hear and act on all protests concerning the tournament.
- 10. YOUTH BOWLER ETIQUETTE.
  - a. Bowlers are required to stay in the bowlers' area. Parents, coaches and other spectators will not be allowed in the bowlers' area. Obscene language or gestures are not permitted. Final decision on tournament attire and behavior rest with the tournament director.
  - Bowlers shall not play coin-operated devices while bowling in this tournament.
  - c. There shall be no use of tobacco products or consumption of alcoholic beverages by youth participants or other persons in the area used by the youth bowlers during tournament, defined as the lanes, bowlers' area, and concourse area directly behind the lanes being used by the youth bowlers.
  - d. Bowlers may be disqualified for any infraction of the rules or for conduct detrimental to the best interests of this tournament or the game of bowling, either on or off the lanes.
  - e. Bowlers will only be given one warning by the tournament director reference any rule violation.
- If the Junior Gold bowler advancing must withdraw from the National Junior Gold Tournament immediately inform the Association Manager at manager@bowlkilleenforthood.org as well as contact the JG offices at USBC.
- COMBINED DIVISION. Must have at least 5 entries in a division to have separate divisions. Tournament director has the authority to combine divisions as deemed necessary.
