- 1. <u>ANNUAL TOURNAMENT.</u> The Annual Youth Handicap Championship Tournament of the Greater Killeen-Fort Hood USBC Association shall be certified by the USBC and consist of a 3-game individual event with an option of virtual doubles. Side events may be offered onsite for scholarship funds.
- 2. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>. The tournament shall be open to all youth bowlers in good standing with USBC and have a current USBC card for the 2022-2023 season.
- 3. $\underline{\text{DIVISIONS}}_{.}$ There are three divisions for each this event based on averages.

Division	Average
1	140 +
2	100 – 139
3	< 100

- 4. <u>HANDICAP AND ENTERING AVERAGES</u> The handicap allowance for shall be 100% and be based on the difference between each bowler's entering average and 220. Each bowler's entering average shall be based on the following priorities:
- Rule A Highest 2021-2022 USBC winter average of the previous season of 21 or more games.
- b. Rule B Use **2022** summer league (including travel leagues) average of 15 or more games.

- c. Rule C Highest current average of 9 or more games as of the date of participation in this tournament. Verification of average standing sheet or verification signed by the center's youth coach must be presented prior to bowling.
- d. Rule D All other will bowl scratch.
- 5. <u>AWARDS</u>. Awards shall be returned 100% for the event. There will be at least 1 prize for each 8 entries. Scholarship funds will be given as awards and submitted to SMART accounts. In the event of a tie, funds will be split amongst the two entries.
